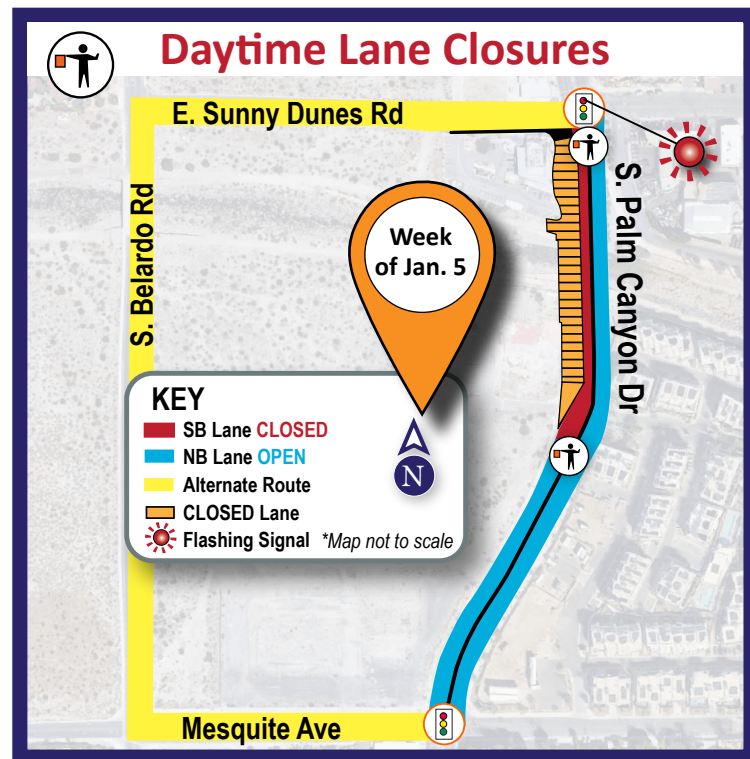

CONSTRUCTION ALERT: Weeks of Jan. 5 and 12, 2026

Daytime lane closures and nighttime road closures planned on S. Palm Canyon Drive starting Jan. 5, expect delays.

Week of Jan. 5 | Daytime Lane Closures;
Sunny Dunes Rd. traffic signal on flash

Monday and Tuesday, Jan. 5 and 6 | 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
One lane open on the bridge; flaggers will direct traffic.
Lane closures are necessary for public safety while crews dig and saw cut for gas line installation.



Palm Tree Relocation

Crews will optimize the planned road closure to relocate 7 palm trees at the northeast end of the project and 2 at the southeast end in preparation for the Phase 2 Traffic Flip. The trees from the north end will be relocated to a city site. The trees at the south end will be replanted in their final location indicated on project plans. Palm tree relocation is expected to take 5 nights.

Week of Jan. 12 | Nightly Road Closures;
Sunny Dunes Rd. traffic signal on flash

Monday, Jan. 12 through Friday, Jan. 16 | 6 p.m. to 4 a.m.
Road closures planned nightly on S. Palm Canyon Drive from E. Sunny Dunes Road to Mesquite Avenue.
Motorists will be detoured to Belardo Road.



What to expect

- Motorists can expect a full road closure with detour in place each night.
- Gasline installation work will be completed on both the north and south ends of the bridge.
- Neighbors can expect usual noise and lighting associated with nighttime construction.
- Crews are planning to complete louder operations, like saw cutting and digging, before 9 p.m.
- Gas service will not be affected.
